1. Born Under the Law
 - a. History
 - i. Created Good/Innocent Genesis 1:31
 - ii. Adam Fell/Nature Corrupted Romans 5:12–13
 - iii. Abraham received the promise of God. Genesis 12:1-2
 - iv. Moses received the law. Exodus 19:1-9
 - b. The Law reveals God's holiness. Psalm 19:7; Leviticus 19:1-8
 - c. The Law reveals man's sinfulness.
 - i. The law reveals sin. Galatians 4:19
 - ii. The law brings a curse. Galatians 3:10-12
 - iii. The law does not redeem. James 2:10; Galatians 3:1–4; Galatians 2:14–16
 1. If I offend someone by breaking the law, how can I undo my offense?
 2. Can I become good by keeping the rest of the law?
 3. If I receive Christ by faith, can the law help me become better?
 4. The law can in no way improve our goodness.
2. To Redeem those Under the Law
 - a. Christ redeemed us from the curse through faith. Galatians 4:13-14
 - b. Christ supplies the Spirit which is our guarantee. Galatians 3:1-6; Romans 8:1-2
 - c. Christ has brought a blessing to those of the faith. Galatians 3:7-9
3. Under the law or faith in Christ?
 - a. Through the law, Scripture has confined all under sin. Galatians 3:19-22
 - b. To bring us to faith in Christ. Galatians 3:22-25
