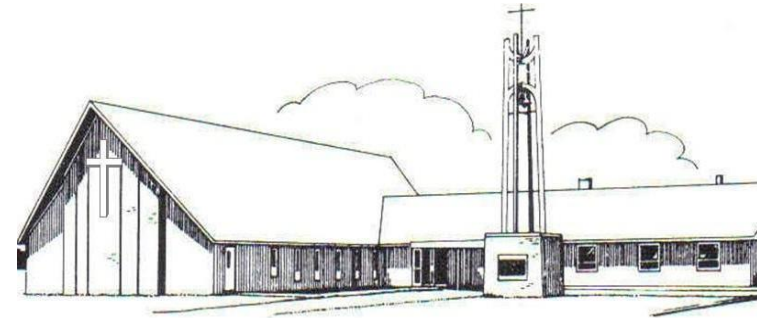
Announcements
